- 1. **Letter of Acceptance:** from Extended Learning. You must apply to a certificate program by submitting a **Certificate Application for International Students** and receive a letter of acceptance **before** you can submit this **International Student Application**.
- 2. **Original TOEFL Score Report**
Have the Education Testing Service (ETS) or Internet English Language Testing System (IELTS) mail your official TOEFL Score Report to SF State on your behalf. (The TOEFL Code Number is 4721). **SFSU does not accept Institutional TOEFL scores.** The one exception is that Institutional TOEFL scores from the American Language Institute (ALI) at San Francisco State University are accepted.
For the TOEFL test, a minimum score of 500 (paper-based test), 173 (computer-based test), or 61 (internet-based test) is required. For the IELTS test, a minimum score of 6 (for undergraduates) and 7.0 for graduates) is required. Original copies **only** will be accepted, no faxes or photocopies.
- 3. **Proof of Finances**
Include a letter from your bank (page 3), or have your bank official certify your funds where indicated on page 6 of this application. Financial Statement Guidelines are on page 4.
- 4. **Health Insurance**
Read and sign the Agreement to Purchase Medical Health Insurance (page 6 of this application).
- 5. **U.S. Immigration Service Documents**
If you are currently enrolled at another school, include a copy of your passport, I-94 card, I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility), and EAD card from your current U.S. School (if any).
- 6. **Fees**
Include a check or money order, payable to *SFSU-CEL* in the amount of \$600 for the non-refundable International Student Application fee. The letter must be the original copy; we do not accept faxes or scanned copies.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT GUIDELINES

(Effective August 2009)

1. Types of Acceptable Financial Statement Documents:

- Undergraduate Admissions, Graduate Studies and ALI will accept original Financial Statement forms. We will also accept copies of original Financial Statement forms submitted by fax or as email attachments. This will allow students to keep original copies for the purpose of their visa interviews with the US Embassy/Consulate.
- Financial Statements must be on the bank/financial institution's letterhead, show contact information, financial institution official's name, title and signature. Applicants may retain the original for their visa interview.
- Financial Statements must be in English. Translations from a translation agency or an appropriate campus authority are acceptable.
- Monthly statements from financial institutions are acceptable as long as said document has the institution's name, address and contact information.
- Documentation of other liquid assets (stocks, bonds, mutual funds, IRA accounts, etc.) are acceptable, applying the same standards used for monthly financial institution statements.
- The Financial Statement can estimate funds in (e.g. "low seven figure amount") in US or non-US currency as long as it meets our financial requirement amounts.
- Scholarship or government loan funds letters that are term-specific may be used only for specified terms, regardless of date of issue. "For Admissions Purpose" Forms from the Saudi Scholarship Funds are acceptable.

2. Dates on Financial Statement Form:

Financial Statements must be current and dated no earlier than 12 months/ 1 year prior to the start of the application term.

- Fall application term starts in August – Financial Statements (FS) must be dated no earlier than August of previous year.
Example: Fall 2011 application term – FS must be dated no earlier than Aug. 2010.
- Spring application term starts in January – Financial Statements must be dated no earlier than January of previous year.
Example: Spring 2012 application term – FS must be dated no earlier than Jan. 2011.

3. Sponsors:

- Sponsors must sign the *Sponsor Agreement* (included in Financial Statement form) or submit a letter which includes the student's full name and semester of enrollment promising to provide financial support along with a bank letter from the sponsor's financial institution verifying adequate funding. Sponsor's signature may be in the native language.

If a sponsor is providing room & board, these costs can be subtracted from the amount shown on the financial statement. The letter must be signed and dated by the person providing the room & board.

III. MEDICAL INSURANCE AGREEMENT

San Francisco State University requires all international students to possess health and medical insurance. You may purchase insurance from the Student Health Center, or use the insurance that you currently have (as long as it meets the minimum requirements). By signing the statement below, you agree to accept the University's health and medical insurance requirements as stated by Student Health services.
