- In Step 1**, international students enrolling in an Extended Learning Certificate Programs must complete a **Certificate Application for International Students** [download from <http://www.cel.sfsu.edu/international>] and a **Certificate Program Application for Academic Programs** [download from <http://www.cel.sfsu.edu/register/forms.cfm>] except for the Digital Video Intensive (DVI).

The cost to process the **Certificate Program Application for Academic Programs** for all programs is \$50, except for the International Business Certificate Program, which is \$100.

DVI applicants must complete the **Certificate Application for International Students** and the **Digital Video Intensive Certificate Application**. The cost to process the **Digital Video Intensive Certificate Application** is \$50.

2. **In Step 2**, the approximate **Cost of Living Expense** in the Bay Area is \$19,250 per year. You must be able to demonstrate through the Proof of Funding documentation in the International Student Application that you can cover this cost for the first year.
3. **International Student Application Processing Fee:** \$600 (includes program advising, Extended Learning administrative fees and student identification card). This is a one-time fee and is due with the student's International Student Application and supporting documentation. This fee is non-refundable. 4. International students must agree to have or obtain insurance coverage for health, medical repatriation and evacuation that meets the NAFSA medical insurance guideline for admission. After admission to SF State, Extended Learning students may purchase medical health insurance through the California State University Approved Health Insurance Policy at <https://wfis.wellsfargo.com/CSU/>.

Students who already have insurance must submit a "Student Affidavit of Health Insurance" form to the SF State Student Health Service (SHS). The affidavit must be completed and signed by the student's medical health insurance provider. For instructions and affidavit form visit:

Students must have medical health insurance before registering for classes. If you have purchased the SF State sponsored health insurance policy, it will be automatically reported to SF State Registrar's Office. For students who have their own medical health insurance, after the Student Health Services has reviewed the affidavit from the student's insurance provider, the Registrar's Office will be notified. If you do not purchase health insurance or show proof of health insurance, you will not be able to enroll in classes. You must also show proof of your Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR) immunization before you can enroll in classes.
