ELDERCOLLEGE AT SF STATE gives people over 50 the opportunity to take any regular university course on a space available, audit basis with instructor approval. This program is offered during the spring, summer and fall semesters. OVER 60 DEGREE PROGRAM AT SF STATE enables people 60 years or older to earn a baccalaureate or master's degree at SF State without paying traditional admission or registration fees. The program is offered through San Francisco State University, not College of Extended Learning.
